A number of you have brought forward concerns about the material covered in BUEC 311.

I have discussed the course with Dr Silva and reiterated those concerns (including the issue that MATH 114 - Elementary Calculus I does not cover topics such as partial derivatives and multivariate optimization).

In response to the issues raised, Dr Silva has offered to adjust Homework Assignments 2 and 3, Midterm 2 and the Final Exam. Each will only cover textbook material and/or textbook questions. Friday's Midterm 1 will consist of material covered to-date.

As Midterm 1 is after today's withdrawal deadline, we want you to make an informed decision if you are considering withdrawing from BUEC 311 and want to wait until after you have the results of Midterm 1.
